



Q1 - Why did you take this course? (Student can select up to 3 responses)




Q2 - About how many hours a week (not counting class periods) did you devote to this course?



I have never taken a sociology course before in my life so this was a very good intro to soc course to teach me more about the topic.








The course load is excellent. I have never felt drained or overwhelmed in this class, however, it has also been a great way to test my knowledge and learn more through essays.




