




Q1 - Why did you take this course? (Student can select up to 3 responses)

Q3 - How would you evaluate your own commitment to and engagement with this course?



Q4 - How much do you think you've learned from this course?




I thought some of the readings were more engaging than others. My least favorite of the readings was Invisible No More.





I enjoy writing essays, so I appreciate that essays were our largest grades.


Q8 - How would you rate the instructor's performance in providing fair, prompt, and helpful comments and grades on your work?


