




Q2 - About how many hours a week (not counting class periods) did you devote to this course?


I have already explored some of the concepts in this course, but I have expanded very much on my knowledge of old and new concepts through this course.


Everything that we used this semester was free of cost and most of the materials were very useful. However, there were a few readings that left me a little bit confused and I had to get more understanding from our discussions in class.

She uses all the time for class in an efficient manner and always has time to answer questions and give examples. She also promotes learning opportunities on campus.


Class sessions were very productive, many great discussions.


Assignments and tests were very fair. At times test questions were difficult but it was a good challenge.




