




I have attended and participated in class. Completed all of my assignments.

I had never come across some of the sociologists we learned in this class, which gave me a much broader knowledge in sociological theories.


I came in knowing the bare basics but I feel relatively confident with most of the materials now.


I loved the format of the moodle page. It was very clear and easy to find everything that was due and readings.

The structure really helped with understanding the course


My instructor was very diligent and engaging during class discussions. This was probably one of my favorite aspects of class.

Not very difficult but were hard enough for me to learn






